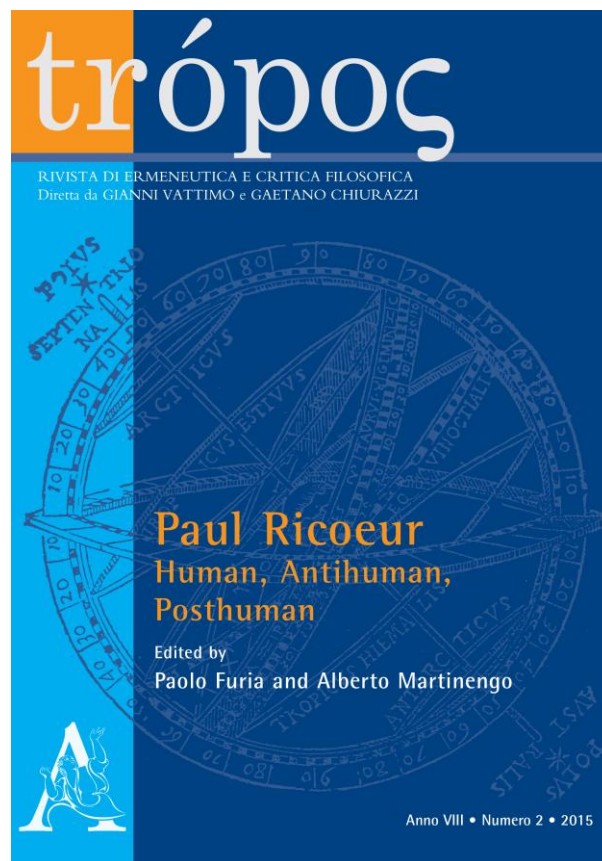

Ten years after Paul Ricoeur's death, *Trópos* discusses the main issues of his thought. Seven contributions deal with Ricoeur's philosophy of the "human" from different perspectives. The aim is to investigate its resources facing new challenges: among others, the reflections on animality, the debates on the posthuman era, the issues concerning the digital identity.
